### *Rules & Regulations*

1. Following receipt of Valid Entry Form - Applicants will be advised and invited to attend an audition at a time and location to be decided
2. Each individual applicant must be
  - **18 and under on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2020**

**Note** Valid form of photographic identification (e.g. Passport, Birth Certs, Young Scot Card.) may be required for age verification

3. All participants taking part in the Competition shall conduct themselves in an appropriate manner. If in the opinion of the organisers of the Competition, a Participant is conducting themselves in any way which adversely affects the Competition or members of the public, the organisers shall be entitled to remove that Participant and they shall be eliminated from all other auditions.
4. Each participant will be expected to perform - maximum audition Act duration 5 minutes – and open to all forms of Entertainment in the Celtic Tradition. Each participating Act will be performed as agreed detail on Entry Form



5. Each set of auditions will be held at various pre advised locations. Dates and times to be determined and all participants will be advised accordingly
6. The judges will select a number of participants from each auditions to go forward to a **Semi-Final/Final** the Winners being given a 'SPOT' **on Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> July 2020** at the Speyfest Tented Village
7. Bands will supply their own guitar amps and backline for the semi-final and final but may be required to share backline if the running time is likely to over run
8. Each participant will be required to fill out, sign and agree to the T & C's including agreement to have photographs used for Press/Marketing purposes
9. Dependant on age the final competitors may require parental consent to take part in the Grand Final.
10. All Finalists will make themselves available to attend the Semi-Final/Finals Date and Venue TBA
11. The organisers decide the running order of the Finals on the afternoon/evening.
12. The Committee reserves the right to amend the rules and regulations if deemed necessary.
13. **The judge(s) decision shall be final and conclusive.**
